Between 31st May and 30th September 2019 volunteers are able to footprint tunnels to enable hedgehog presence and absence to be recorded, helping to build up a picture of how they use the landscape. Whilst our project is primarily interested in hedgehogs, we will be collating information on all recorded species using the tunnel. This information may then be used to target where we provide land management advice as part of our project.

This survey requires the volunteer to choose a 1km grid square to survey, which in this case your land lies within. They will then set up a tunnel in a suitable location and this is left outside to attract tunnels through the night.
